

Other RAFT Activities (page 1 of 2)

Activity Goal

- To help students review a targeted chunk of material

Role	Audience	Format	Topic
Expert	Other students in the class	A list of questions	Questions that you think all students should be able answer about this particular chunk of material
Expert	The teacher	A podcast, perhaps recorded on a smartphone	Links you see between the material you have selected or been assigned and something else that has been studied this year
Expert	Your parents	A visual, including drawings, pictures, and other graphics	Connections you have made among the ideas in your assigned or selected section of the material
Expert	The principal	A bulletin or newsletter	A summary of what your class learned about this particular topic

→ Sometimes, a RAFT can “fix” one of the components as a way to make grading easier for the teacher. Sometimes, “fixing” one of the components can make it easier for the teacher to come up with options for the task.

Other RAFT Activities (page 2 of 2)

Activity Goal

- To enable students to practise oral presentation skills

Role	Audience	Format	Topic
A radio announcer	The general public	A commercial	Topic A from the unit
A teacher	Your students (your classmates)	A three- to five-minute “teacher talk”	Topic B from the unit
A famous person of your choosing and an interviewer (this could be a partner activity)	Your fans	An interview	Topic C from the unit

→ Because this RAFT activity is focusing on helping students practise a particular language skill, it’s easily modified for a variety of contents or units. The topic choices have been left deliberately vague so that you can adjust them to reflect your unit.
