Structured Practice


To be successful in spelling, students must focus on the letters, words, and patterns. For that reason, this series uses structured practice. Rather than changing the activities week-to-week, the daily activities are repeated throughout the 36 units. That way, students can focus on the words instead of learning how to complete the activities.

The following activities are used throughout this book:

Title of Activity	Description
Change a Letter	Students change a letter to create a new word.
Color and Search	Students color pictures with letter sounds and search for letter sounds in a list of words.
Color and Trace	Students find words that begin with the letter of the week and practice writing the letter.
First Sound	Students write the letter they hear in the beginning of words.
Last Sound	Students write the letter they hear at the end of words.
Letter Search	Students distinguish between uppercase and lowercase letters, and then they will trace letters.
Middle Sound	Students write the letter they hear in the middle of words.
Picture Match	Students match words to corresponding pictures.
Read, Write, Match	Students read a word, write the word, and find the matching picture of the word.
Rhyming Words	Students search for rhyming words.
Short Stories	Students read short stories and search for words that match the spelling pattern.
Stretch the Words	Students stretch words and write the letters they hear.
Tapping Sounds	Students tap sounds out and write the letters they hear.


