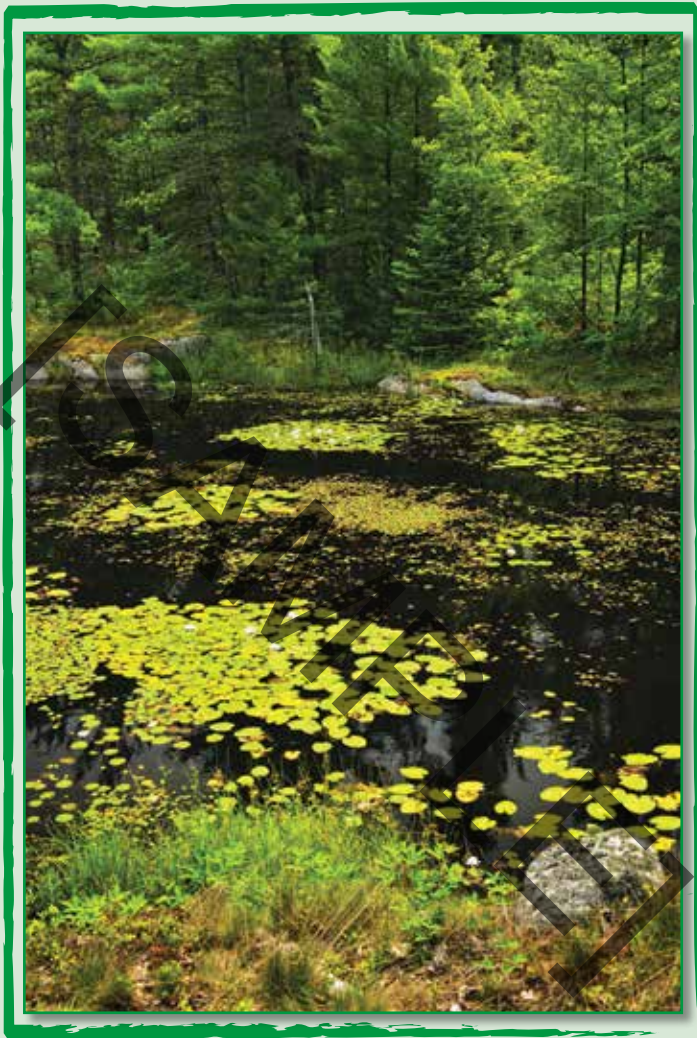

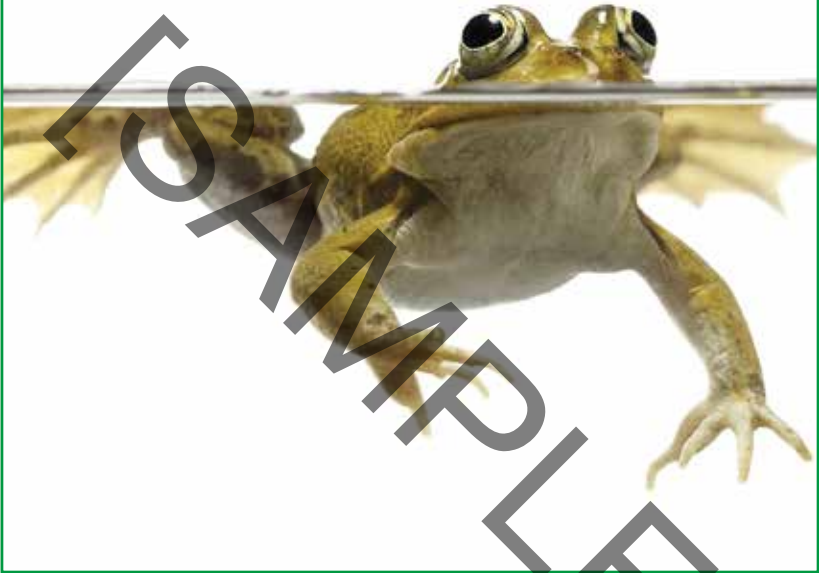


It all begins at the pond.

mother frog.**

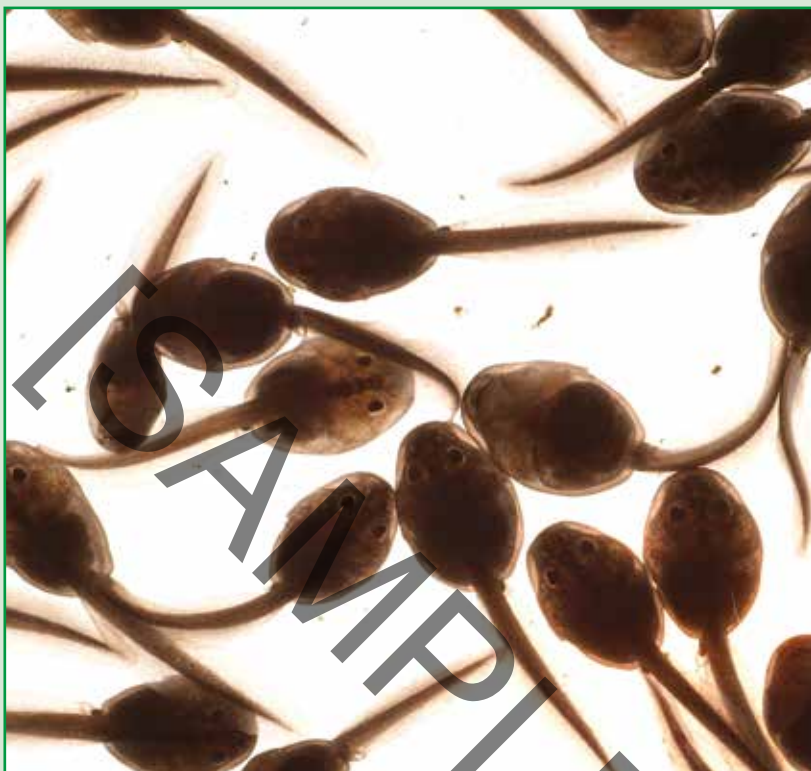




She is ready to have babies.

Then it grows four legs.



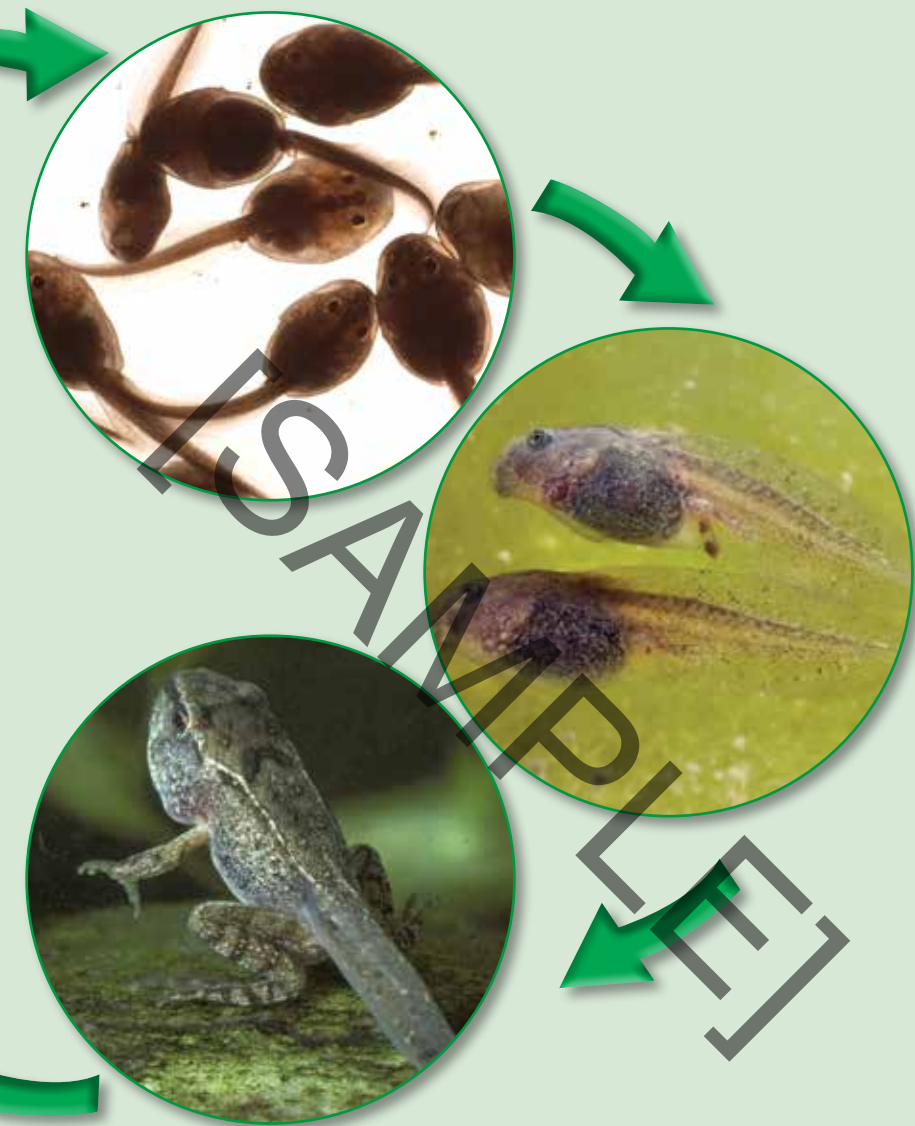
**Each young frog becomes
