Unpacking Instructions:

You will receive an assembled display/storage box with the following components inside from left to right.

Each component is shrink-wrapped (with the exception of the Teacher's Guide).

1. 24 Reading Passages (180 total cards; shrink-wrapped in three bundles)
2. 24 Dividers (shrink-wrapped in one bundle)
3. 1 Teacher's Guide

How to organize your box:

1. There are 180 shrink-wrapped Reading Passages. They should be placed in order from Grades 1–10, starting at the left side of the box.
2. The 24 dividers should be placed between each set of cards.
3. The Teacher's Guide can be placed at the far right side of the box, after the Reading Passages.

Digital Access:

You will find a unique digital access code printed on the inside of the front cover of the Teacher's Guide. This code provides five-year access to the companion website at lsa.pearson.com. The access code can be used in three sessions at one time.
