

Mathology.ca, Frequently Asked Questions

What can I share from Mathology.ca?

In general, you can share content with students within password-protected systems. You cannot share with other educators. When your access ends, so does your permission to share. Is Mathology.ca aligned to the new ON curriculum?

Yes. Mathology.ca is aligned to the new Ontario curriculum, as shown in the <u>correlation</u> <u>documents</u>. Pearson is working toward 100% curriculum coverage.

Is Math Makes Sense aligned to the new ON curriculum?

Yes, Math Makes Sense is aligned to the new Ontario curriculum, as shown in the <u>alignment charts</u>. However, MMS does not provide 100% coverage of the new curriculum. Mathology is Pearson's Math resource that will provide 100% curriculum coverage.

What can I edit in Mathology.ca?

Mathology.ca includes, with each online activity, a reproducible page that you can edit to suit your students' needs. There are reproducible pages that you can edit in the some of the digital Mathology Little Books. You can also build a customized teaching plan.

If I purchase Mathology.ca at one grade, do I get access to all grades?

Yes. Each license purchased by or for a teacher gives that teacher access to all available grades in Mathology.ca. Each license is for one single teacher only, and cannot be shared.

If I buy Mathology Little Books in print, can I also access them digitally, and how?

Yes. There is a URL printed on the back of each Little Book. The URL takes you to a digital and audio version of the book, and an accompanying activity. The URL does not appear on the back of the K lapbooks.
