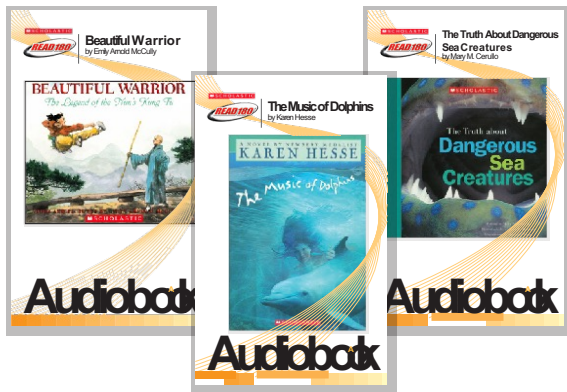


Stage A Independent Reading
