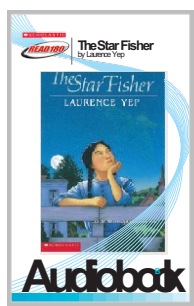
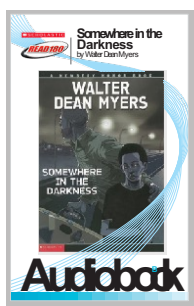
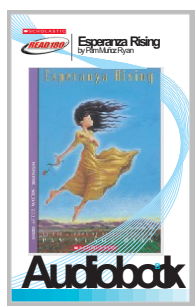


Stage B Independent Reading
