



# Phonics Scope and Sequence

The Reading & Writing Project at Mossflower's decodable text series systematically introduces beginning readers to new letter-sound correspondences and high-frequency words. The books also feature engaging characters, adventurous plots, and key elements of literary fiction. While all series generally follow the same phonics scope and sequence, some variations exist. The following phonics scope and sequence outlines the alignment and explains any deviations.

For the first four series, both the *Moonlit Mountain Readers* and the *Jump Rope Readers* invite readers to exercise the most beginning phonics topic: alphabet knowledge.

The Jump Rope Readers
does this by featuring one
to two letter-sound
correspondences per book
(with the exception of Book
1). The words these letters
appear in might have twofive sounds in them--words
like "at," "nap," "snap."
Jump Rope Readers ensures
practice with every letter
sound across Series 1-5.

The Moonlit Mountain
Readers emphasizes
extended practice with the
short vowel sounds, and
includes consonants in
batches. The words the
short vowels appear in are
two- and three-sound
words (CVC), like "at" and
"nap" until Series 4 Blends,
where four-six sound-words
like "snap" and "past" and
"blast" are featured.

This is a place where the phonics sequence diverges. In Jump Rope Readers, the Blue Series primarily features CV words and the Purple Series primarily features digraphs, in that order. *Moonlit Mountain* Readers features digraphs first, then CV words, which more closely matches the timing that digraphs are taught in the RUOS. We tried to keep colors matched to content. We kept the CV-focused series in blue and the digraphsfocused series in purple and imagined that readers of Jump Rope Readers Purple could access Moonlit Mountain Readers Purple and then move on to Moonlit Mountain Readers Blue.
