Text Feature	Definition	Give an Example
Title	- The name given to a text or sec- tion of a text. It gives the reader an idea of what the text is about.	
Heading	<ul> <li>A descriptor that helps you to recognize a section of information.</li> <li>A subheading is used to label sections within a section.</li> </ul>	
Bulleted or numbered lists	- Lines introduced by a small shape, number, or letter. They may be items in a list, steps in a procedure, a set of examples, etc.	
Illustrations	- Drawings (or sometimes photos) that accompany the text. They may be included to add visual interest, and they may also help support readers' understanding of the text's content.	
Boldface	- Type that is darker and heavier than the rest of the type. This is often used for emphasis.	
Italics	<ul> <li>Type that is slanted to the right. This may be used for emphasis. It may also be used for the title of a complete work, such as a book or poem.</li> </ul>
