

Identifying Shapes in Designs Behaviours/Strategies		
<p>Student does not have a mental image of a triangle, rectangle, or square and cannot identify them.</p>	<p>Student recognizes some triangles, squares, and rectangles but does not recognize them when they are oriented differently.</p> 	<p>Student finds some shapes but has difficulty seeing how shapes can be combined to make other shapes.</p>
Observations/Documentation		
<p>Student finds some shapes but has difficulty finding smaller shapes within larger shapes.</p>	<p>Student thinks all the shapes in the design have been found.</p>	<p>Student successfully identifies triangles, rectangles, and squares of all different sizes and orientations in the design. (Note: Student is not expected to find all shapes in the design.)</p>
