More Increasing Patterns

The dashed box contains three rows of patterns:

- Row 1:** Four patterns of squares. The first has 5 squares (a vertical column of 3 with two squares on the sides). The second has 8 squares (a vertical column of 4 with two squares on each side). The third has 11 squares (a vertical column of 5 with two squares on each side). The fourth has 14 squares (a vertical column of 6 with two squares on each side).
- Row 2:** Three patterns of squares. The first is a diagonal line of 4 squares. The second is a 3x3 square with the top-right corner missing (7 squares). The third is a 4x4 square with the top-right corner missing (13 squares).
- Row 3:** Three patterns of squares. The first is a vertical column of 2 squares. The second is a horizontal row of 3 squares with one square in the center above it. The third is a horizontal row of 5 squares with one square in the center above it.
