More Increasing Patterns

The first row contains four patterns of squares:

- Pattern 1: A central vertical column of 2 squares, with 1 square on each side of the top square.
- Pattern 2: A central vertical column of 3 squares, with 2 squares on each side of the top square.
- Pattern 3: A central vertical column of 4 squares, with 3 squares on each side of the top square.
- Pattern 4: A central vertical column of 5 squares, with 4 squares on each side of the top square.

The second row contains three patterns of squares:

- Pattern 1: A diagonal line of 3 squares.
- Pattern 2: A 3x3 square grid.
- Pattern 3: A 4x4 square grid.

The third row contains three patterns of squares:

- Pattern 1: A vertical column of 2 squares.
- Pattern 2: A horizontal row of 3 squares with a 1x1 square on top of the middle square.
- Pattern 3: A horizontal row of 5 squares with a 1x1 square on top of the third square.
