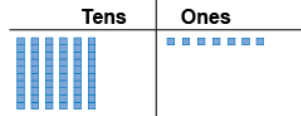

Representing Numbers in Different Ways

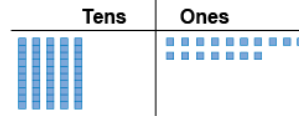
Composing and Decomposing 3-Digit Numbers

Composes and decomposes using tens and ones (one way)



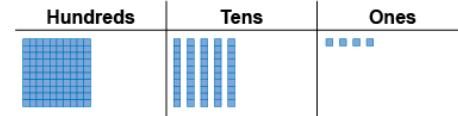
"I modelled 67."

Composes and decomposes using tens and ones (more than one way)



"I traded a ten for 10 ones."

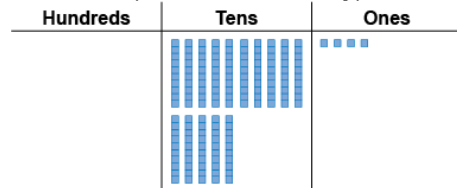
Composes and decomposes using hundreds, tens, and ones (one way)



"I modelled 154."

Composes and decomposes using hundreds, tens, and ones (more than one way)



"I traded the hundred for 10 tens."

Uses place value to write a number in different ways

"One hundred fifty-four
 $154 = 100 + 50 + 4$;
 1 hundred, 5 tens, 4 ones;
 1 hundred, 4 tens, 14 ones
 □|||||♦♦♦♦"

Understands relationships among digits

"The digit 4 in 429 represents
 4 hundreds, 40 tens, or 400 ones."
