Phonics Focus Horners focus p age 2, ask your child what is similar about the words *plans* and *place*. Guide them to see that they both start with pl. Have your child say each letter separately and then practice bending the sounds. Togther, list other words that start with pl.

Have your child create three to five movements that relate to pages in the book. For example, they could pretend to get off a tram for page 3, pretend to step on the gas for page 6, and pretend to whack toy frogs for page 10. Connection to Art
